XXVIII International Scientific Conference "Problems of Continuous Geographic Education and Cartography" will be held on 6-8 th October 2020 at the Department of Physical Geography and Cartography of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University.

Organizers: V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University, Department of Science and Education of Kharkiv Regional State Administration, Institute of Geography NAS of Ukraine, the Research Institute of Geodesy and Cartography, «Kharkiv Academy of Continuous Education», Institute of Pedagogy of the National Academy of Pedagogical Sciences of Ukraine, State Scientific and Production Enterprise «Kartographia», «SchidGeoInform», the Joint-stock Company «Institute of Advanced Technologies», Geography Teachers' Association of Ukraine, Ukrainian Geographical Society.

Media sponsors: «Ukrainian Geographical Journal», journals «Geography and Economics in modern school» (Kyiv), «Geography» (Kharkiv), the newspaper «Regional studies. Geography. Tourism» (Kyiv).

During the conference it is planned to discuss current issues of practical training of students and pupils in the system of continuous geographical education and cartography, summarize the experience and consider the prospects for the development and implementation of innovative educational technologies into the learning process, new by the topic, content and structure maps, atlases, GIS technologies, training programs, educational literature and software.

For foreign participants it is planned to hold thematic excursions in Kharkiv city and Kharkiv region, the university centers of students' practice, Kharkiv industrial enterprises and educational institutions.

Prior to the conference, two issues (Nos. 31 and 32) of the scientific collection of works "Problems of Continuous Geographic Education and Cartography" will be published, with articles on the topic of the conference. The collection of works is recognized as a professional scientific publication, where the results of the dissertation works for obtaining the degrees of Doctor and Candidate of geographical sciences can be published. Scientific articles to be included in the periodical are accepted until **April 30, 2020** by the technical secretary N.V. Svir at the office of geographical disciplines teaching methods (room. 4-73 of the main building of KhNU), and in electronic form at progoik@physgeo.com or by mail: **Svir Natalia Viktorovna**, **Department of Physical Geography and Cartography**, V.N. The scientific paper is accepted for publication in Ukrainian, English or Russian, three abstracts of the article.

Abstracts are submitted in three languages with a volume of 2000 characters - Ukrainian, Russian, English, and the title of the article and the author's name must be translated into three languages (for foreign participants the Ukrainian annotation will be prepared

by the editorial board). Keywords are added to the abstracts: 5 to 8 words or phrases. Abstract requirements in English: informative (do not contain general sentences); content (reflect the main content of the article and research findings); structured (the following sections are distinguished: The purpose of this article. The main material. Conclusions and further research).

Requirements for the content and design of the article:

- 1. The article must be original, not previously published and correspond to the topics of the scientific collection: geography, questions of teaching methodology, cartography, geodesy, GIS and GDZ.
- 2. Total amount of article: minimum 15, maximum 20 pages (including tables and illustrative material). The article is submitted **on A-4 paper** in duplicate (one copy is signed by the author / coauthors) and in electronic form by e-mail in Word format (font Times New Roman, font size -14, spacing -1.5, margins 2 cm, paragraph indent 1.25). Pages are not numbered.
- 3. According to the requirements for professional periodical, a scientific article should have the following **structural elements**:
- **Introduction** statement of the problem in general form and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks.
- **Prerequisites** analysis of recent research to examine the problem and publications that initiate the solution to the problem and which the author relies on, selection of previously unresolved parts of the general problem that this article is devoted to.
- The purpose of the article
- Presentation of the main material with full justification of scientific results
- Conclusions from this study and the prospects for further research in this scientific field.
- **References** (up to 15 sources, one third of which published in the last 5 years), designed according to the new state standard. References to bibliographic sources are given in the text, numbered in square brackets: [1], [2], etc., and in citation [1, p. 240]. Below is **a list of references** (Cyrillic transliterated into Latin) and a **translation into English.** The list must be drawn up in accordance with international standards (e.g. APA). Transliteration: from the Ukrainian language: http://translit.kh.ua/, from the Russian language: http://translit.cc/.

The article must contain **the names** of these structural elements.

4. Placement on page:

In the upper left-hand corner, in plain text, is the UDC index (1st line), the author's first and last name; the scientific degree, academic title, place of work (2nd line), ID ORCID (3rd line),

e-mail of the author (4th line), address of university (enterprise) with indication of the index. Below is the title of the article in capital letters (size 14, bold, center alignment). Below - in one line - three annotations (size 12, space 1) and the text of the article (without word transfer). The the reviewer' data and the list of references are given at the end of the text (size 12 pins, space 1.5)

- 5. The article **should not contain** fuzzy photos and bulky tables. Maps and map legends must be clear. All graphics must be computer-generated **in black and white**.
- 6. The article must be carefully edited and its **electronic and printed variants must be identical.**

In addition, the authors submit in a separate file personal data in Ukrainian, Russian and English languages: surname, name, patronymic, academic degree, academic rank, place of work, position, postal address of the institution with the index, contact telephone, e-mail, ORCID ID.

Each participant of the conference submits only one article (single or co-authored, but no more than 5). If the content or design of the article does not meet the requirements for professional

scientific collections, it will not be included in the collection. The application for participation in the conference can be submitted without the article. In this case, the report, if it is relevant to the topic of the conference, will be included in the program.

TERMS OF PAYMENT OF ARTICLES IN THE COLLECTION OF PAPERS

The cost of publishing **one article** in the scientific journal "Problems of Continuing Geographic Education and Cartography" is equivalent to \$ 20US.

Sending of scientific collections will be for a **separate fee.**
