The Organizing Committee invites you to attend the XXVII International Scientific Conference on the topic:
«Problems of Continuous Geographic Education and Cartography»

XXVIII International Scientific Conference "Problems of Continuous Geographic Education and Cartography" will be held on **8-9 th October 2025** at the Department of Physical Geography and Cartography of V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University.

Organizers: V. N. Karazin Kharkiv National University, Department of Science and Education of Kharkiv Regional State Administration, Institute of Geography NAS of Ukraine, the Research Institute of Geodesy and Cartography, «Kharkiv Academy of Continuous Education», State Scientific and Production Enterprise «Kartographia», «SchidGeoInform», the Joint-stock Company «Institute of Advanced Technologies», Geography Teachers' Association of Ukraine, Ukrainian Geographical Society.

The conference is registered in the database of scientific and technical events of Ukraine UkrISTEI (State Scientific Institution in the Field of Management of the Ministry of Education and Science of Ukraine). Certificate No. 586 by 12/22/2022.

During the conference it is planned to discuss current issues of practical training of students and pupils in the system of continuous geographical education and cartography, summarize the experience and consider the prospects for the development and implementation of innovative educational technologies into the learning process, new by the topic, content and structure maps, atlases, GIS technologies, training programs, educational literature and software.

Prior to the conference, two issues of the collection of scientific papers "Problems of Continuous Geographic Education and Cartography" will be published, with articles on the topic of the conference. The collection of works is recognized as a professional scientific publication, where the results of the dissertation works for obtaining the degrees of Doctor and Candidate of Geographical Sciences can be published.

The periodical is included in the following international scientific databases:

The scientific paper is accepted for publication in Ukrainian or English, two abstracts of the article.

Abstracts are submitted in both languages with a volume of 2000 characters - Ukrainian, English, and the title of the article and the author's name must be translated into both languages (for foreign participants the Ukrainian annotation will be prepared by the editorial board). Keywords are added to the abstracts: 5 to 8 words or phrases. Abstract requirements in English: informative (do not contain general sentences); content (reflect the main content of the article and research findings); structured (the following sections are distinguished: The purpose of this article. The main material. Conclusions and further research).

Requirements for the content and design of the article:

1. The article must be original, not previously published and correspond to the topics of the scientific collection: geography, questions of teaching methodology, cartography, geodesy, GIS and Remote Sensing.

2. Total amount of article: minimum - 15, maximum - 20 pages (including tables and illustrative material). The article is submitted in electronic form (to e-mail vilinaperesadko@karazin.ua or a.pilugin@karazin.ua) in Word format (font Times New Roman, font size – 14, spacing – 1.5, margins - 2 cm, paragraph - indent 1.25). Pages are not numbered.

3. According to the requirements for professional periodicals, a scientific article should have the following structural elements:

- *Introduction* - statement of the problem in general form and its connection with important scientific or practical tasks.

- *Prerequisites* - analysis of recent research to examine the problem and publications that initiate the solution to the problem and which the author relies on, selection of previously unresolved parts of the general problem that this article is devoted to.

- *The purpose of the article.*

- *Presentation of the main material* with full justification of scientific results.

- *Conclusions* from this study and the prospects for further research in this scientific field.

- *References* (up to 15 sources, one third of which published in the last 5 years), given at the end of the article in alphabetical order and designed according to the new state standard DSTU 8302:2015. The editorial board will reject Russian-language sources.

Below is a list of references translated into English. The list must be drawn up in accordance with international standards (e.g. APA).

References to bibliographic sources are given in the text, numbered in square brackets [], with the order number, and with the pages, in some cases.

The article must contain **the titles** of these structural elements.

4. Placement on page:

In the upper left-hand corner, in plain text, is the UDC index (1st line), the author's first and last name; the scientific degree, academic title, place of work (2nd line), ID ORCID (3rd line), e-mail of the author (4th line), address of university (enterprise) with indication of the index. Below is the title of the article in capital letters (size 14, bold, center alignment). Below - in one line - two annotations (size 12, space 1) and the text of the article (without word transfer). The reviewer's data and the list of references are given at the end of the text (size 12 pins, space 1, bold).

5. The article **should not contain** blurred photos and bulky tables. Maps and map legends must be clear. All graphics must be computer-generated.

6. The article must be carefully edited.

In addition, **the authors submit in a separate file personal data in Ukrainian and English languages: surname, name, patronymic, academic degree, academic rank, place of work, position, postal address of the institution with the index, contact telephone, e-mail, ORCID ID.**

ATTENTION!

During the war in Ukraine, the collection of scientific papers will be published exclusively in electronic form.

Each author submits only one article to the collection (solo or co-authored). If the content or design of the article does not meet the requirements, it will not be included in the collection. The editorial board of the journal carries out external and internal reviews of all submitted articles and checks for plagiarism. After receiving confirmation of acceptance of the article for publication from the editorial board, details for paying the publication fee are provided. By decision of the editorial board, articles submitted in English will be published free of charge.

The Editorial Board assigns an international digital identifier DOI to each published article.
